2025 continues to be a year of progress.

Since 2003 when *People for People Foundation* (a 501c3 grassroots organization) started, our organization (along with partner agencies) has assisted numerous individuals and families with utility assistance along with providing valuable resource and referral services.

People for People still partners with **SHARES**. As you may know, **SHARES** provides energy assistance to moderate and lower-income households experiencing a financial crisis. Eligibility is based on household size and income.

People for People supports the **SHARES** programs with processing and submitting applications from **eligible** clients in need.

To date, *People for People* has processed approximately **279** applicants needing utility assistance with funds of over **\$116,300** granted to clients, and there's more to come.

VETERANS DAY

Veterans Day (originally known as **Armistice Day**) is a federal holiday in the United States observed annually for honoring military veterans of the United States Armed Forces. It coincides with holidays in several countries, including Armistice Day and Remembrance Day, which also occur on the anniversary of the end of World War I. Major hostilities of World War I were formally ended at the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month of 1918 when the Armistice with Germany went into effect. At the urging of major U.S. veteran organizations, Armistice Day was renamed Veterans Day in 1954.

Veterans Day is distinct from Memorial Day. Veterans Day commemorates the service of all U.S. veterans, while Memorial Day, which grew out of Civil War commemorations, specifically honors those who have died while in military service. Another military holiday that also occurs in May, Armed Forces Day, honors those currently serving in the U.S. military. Additionally, Women Veterans Day is recognized by a growing number of U.S. states that specifically honor women who have served in the U.S. military.

This year, Veterans day falls on Tuesday, November 11, 2025.

THANKSGIVING

Thanksgiving can land earlier or later in the month, so knowing how much time you have before the big feast is super important.

Thanksgiving always falls on the fourth Thursday of November. In 1863, during the Civil War, President Abraham Lincoln issued a Thanksgiving proclamation asking Americans to set aside the last Thursday of November as a day of thanksgiving. After that, it became the norm to hold the holiday on that day.

In the 1930s, there were two years when Thanksgiving fell on the fifth Thursday of November However, business owners complained to President Franklin D. Roosevelt that this would hurt retailers because there was less time to shop for Christmas. To remedy this, Congress passed a law in 1941 that officially made Thanksgiving the fourth Thursday of every November.

Native American cultures, too, have a rich tradition of giving thanks at harvesttime feasts, which began long before Europeans appeared on their soil. And well after the Pilgrims, for more than two centuries, individual colonies and states celebrated days of thanksgiving.

This year, Thanksgiving falls on Thursday, November 27, 2025.

Shop Smart


- Consider shopping online to avoid crowds

COOKING CORNER



Slow-Cooker Ham with Fruit Chutney

Tangy fruits cover this ham while slow cooking melds the flavors into a delicious change from a more traditional pineapple glaze

Ingredients

- 1 (3 lbs.) fully cooked smoked boneless ham
- 1/4 tsp pepper
- 2 jars (6 oz each) jerk seasoning sauce or fruit chutney (1½ cups)
- 1 cup diced dried fruit and raisin mixture
- 1 cup frozen small whole onions
- 1 tbsp balsamic vinegar

Directions

- Place ham in 3½- to 4-quart slow cooker. Sprinkle with pepper. Mix remaining ingredients; pour over ham.
- Cover and cook on low heat setting 6 to 8 hours. Note: This recipe was tested in slow cookers with heating elements in the side and bottom of the cooker, not in cookers that stand only on a heated base. For slow cookers with just a heated base, follow the manufacturer's directions for layering ingredients and choosing a temperature.

The new affordable housing community, in Verona, NJ. This community has 95 available apartments, underscoring the immense demand for affordable housing in the area.
