**People for People** continues to partner with the **SHARES** programs in processing and submitting applications from **eligible** clients in need.

As of December **2025**, **People for People** has processed approximately **311** applicants needing utility assistance with funds of over **\$126,000** granted to clients. Quite an achievement!

#### WREATHS OF REMEMBRANCE



On December 6, 2025, the People for People Foundation of Gloucester County will host the **16**<sup>th</sup> **Annual Wreaths of Remembrance** Ceremony at the Gloucester County Veteran's Memorial Cemetery in Monroe Township, NJ. Collectively with the Gloucester County Department of Veterans Administration, Lora and Rich Gess and the Rotary Club of Glassboro and hundreds of volunteers, 4000 wreaths will be placed on the graves while saying words of gratitude to honor the deceased veterans.

Family members of the interred are asked to arrive by 9:00 am for a short reception and then a private laying of wreaths on their family member's graves. Starting at 9:30 am, a formal memorial ceremony is held by local dignitaries and the laying of wreaths at the memorial sites of the different branches of the military. Volunteers will then lay wreaths on the balance of the graves. The event is opened to the public.

Due to the large numbers of participants all parking will be at the Williamstown Middle School parking lot which is one mile from the cemetery. Shuttle buses will transport the volunteers to the cemetery starting at 8:15 am. Handicap designated cars ONLY will be allowed to park at the cemetery. There will be handicap accessible buses running from the high school as well. Please comply with all parking instructions.

#### **COOKING CORNER**



#### **Pumpkin Cheesecake**

Pumpkin cheesecake is the perfect autumn dessert. Much sweeter and creamier than pumpkin pie, it's an indulgent finisher to your fall meals.

#### **Ingredients**

#### Crust

13/4 cups graham cracker crumbs (about 24 squares)

2 tbsp granulated sugar

½ cup butter or margarine, melted

#### Fillina

¼ cup Gold Medal™ all-purpose flour

2 tsp pumpkin pie spice

2 tbsp brandy, if desired

1 can (15 oz) pumpkin (not pumpkin pie mix)

4 packages (8 oz each) cream cheese, softened

1 cup packed brown sugar

2/3 cup granulated sugar

**5** eggs

#### **Directions**

- ♦ Heat oven to 325°F. Grease 9-inch springform pan with shortening. Wrap foil around pan to catch drips. In small bowl, mix cracker crumbs, 2 tablespoons granulated sugar and the melted butter. Press crumb mixture in bottom of pan. Wrap foil around outside of pan to prevent drips. Bake crust 8 to 10 minutes or until set. Cool 5 minutes at room temperature. Refrigerate about 5 minutes or until completely cooled.
- ♦ Meanwhile, in another small bowl, whisk flour, pumpkin pie spice, brandy and pumpkin together until well blended; set aside. In large bowl, beat cream cheese with electric mixer on medium speed until smooth and creamy. Gradually beat in brown sugar and 2/3 cup granulated sugar until smooth. On low speed, beat in 1 egg at a time just until blended. Gradually beat in pumpkin mixture until smooth.
- ♦ Pour filling over crust. Bake 1 hour 15 minutes to 1 hour 25 minutes or until set but center of cheesecake still jiggles slightly when moved. Turn oven off; open oven door at least 4 inches. Let cheesecake remain in oven 30 minutes.

#### **COOKING CORNER** (cont.)

- ♦ Run knife around edge of pan to loosen cheesecake. Cool in pan on wire rack 30 minutes. Refrigerate at least 6 hours or overnight before serving.
- ♦ To serve, run knife around edge of pan to loosen cheesecake. Carefully remove side of pan before cutting cheesecake. Store covered in refrigerator.

#### REMINDER...

Residents in need of transportation may contact the *People for People* office to make an appointment for transportation service.

- Request MUST be at least 24 hours in advance
- Van service is for <u>LOCAL</u> designations <u>ONLY</u>
- ♦ Passengers MUST BE AMBULATORY
- Van service to local doctor appointments are for <u>VETERANS</u> <u>ONLY</u>
- ◆ Doctor appointments are for MORNING ONLY (Van service is not available for afternoon appointments)
- Seating is limited to 5 adult passengers (No children)
- ♦ Van service is not available on Fridays (NO EXCEPTIONS)

#### The Cove at Palmyra—Palmyra

Family development located in Palmyra, NJ. Family development with 8 units set aside for veterans at risk of homelessness. Completion scheduled for 2025.

#### Liberty Landing—East Greenwich

Liberty Landing located in East Greenwich, NJ. Family development with 70 total units with 35 veteran preference units. 5 units designated for veterans at risk of being homeless. Completion scheduled for 2025.

#### Third and Water-Swedesboro

Located in Swedesboro, Gloucester County, NJ. This vibrant new community will be a valuable addition to South Jersey. Completion scheduled for 2025.

#### Three Bridges at Readington—Hunterdon County

Located in Readington, Hunterdon County, New Jersey. This new community has 80 high-quality apartment homes with 5 units set aside for veterans at risk of being homeless. Completion scheduled for 2025.

#### Valor Pointe-Middlesex County

Our newest community in Monroe Township, NJ. This modern development features 80 thoughtfully designed apartment homes, offering residents spacious and comfortable living spaces.

#### Verona Flats—Essex County

The new affordable housing community, in Verona, NJ. This community has 95 available apartments, underscoring the immense demand for affordable housing in the area.

#### Woodland View—Camden County

Applications are now open for Woodland View Apartments, our newest community in Waterford Township, NJ. This community will house 95 families in a townhouse/flat, and provide 13 apartments that are solely dedicated to homeless veterans. Completion scheduled for 2025.
