As 2026 continues, *People for People* still helps many individuals and families who seek utility assistance as well as providing them with valuable resource and referral services.

People for People partners with the SHARES programs in processing and submitting applications from eligible clients in need.

To date, *People for People* has processed approximately **173** applicants needing utility assistance with funds of over **\$52,500** granted to clients and we're still marching forward.

Venture Partnership

People for People's joint venture with *Conifer Realty, Inc.* provides permanent housing for low to moderate income families with a veteran preference; the first partnership in the United States built to provide permanent housing to veterans, their families and the surviving spouses of veterans.

People for People and *Conifer Realty, Inc.* ventures continues to expand. *Current ventures are listed on the last page of the newsletter.*

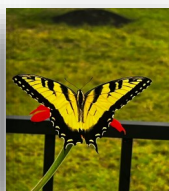

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More Summertime Fun - 2026

Still looking for things to do this summer in South Jersey? There are a variety of fun activities to take part in if you look around. Here are more happenings around town that may peak your interest.

Salem County Fair

This old-fashioned country fair typically features livestock shows, events, and a large display of farm machinery. Savor the delicious BBQ dinner served nightly, or try the other food vendors. Kids will love the tractor and truck pulls, too.

Cost: No admission fee; parking \$20 per vehicle; Salem County Fairgrounds – 735 Rt. 40, Woodstown, NJ 08098

Atlantic County 4-H Fair

It's not a fair without a car show, baby parade, pet parade, and pie-eating contest. Details are still coming together for the 2026 event, so check the link frequently for updates. *Cost: Free admission, \$5 for parking; 3210 Route 50, South Egg Harbor City, NJ*

Sunflower Festival

This festival is a great way to celebrate these gorgeous flowers, along with live music, tasty food, farm-fun activities, and more. Make sure you stay to take the perfect photo during golden hour. *Argos Farm, 1250 Lacey Road, Forked River, NJ 08731*

Bridgeton Peach Festival

This event will host a peach-fuzz contest for babies under 1 year old. Also, look out for many peach treats and decor from merchants and vendors. *Cost: Parking is \$2 per car; 97 Trench Road, Bridgeton, NJ 08302*

Diggerland USA Ropes Course

Travel across the construction theme park on a 700-foot zipline in a side-by-side seat while taking in a panoramic view from a 130-foot tower, or take a wild ride on The Soaring Eagle Zipline. Are you brave enough to climb four stories high? Test out one of the tallest ropes courses in the world at the Diggerland Ropes Course (definitely not for those with a fear of heights).

Raiders Ark – Playland's Castaway Cove

The whole family can make their way through this obstacle course that takes you on ropes, bridges, and zig-zags, going up as high as some of the rides on the boardwalk. Finish off the adventure by sliding down the vast, tunneled slide and landing back on the boards. Kids must be 42" to go alone and 36" with an adult. *1020 Boardwalk, Ocean City, NJ 08226*

Tree to Tree Cape May Adventure Park

Say yes to new adventures with challenging obstacles at the Cape May County Zoo as you explore nature through ziplines, Tarzan swings, nets, and climbing courses. The color-coded routes become more complex as you go, challenging your kids' minds and bodies with over 100 aerial adventure activities. After, make sure you stop by and say hi to the animals at the zoo (it's *free*, so why not?).

Cowtown Rodeo | Saturdays through September 26

Giddy-up and get out for a night of family fun at Cowtown Rodeo in Pilesgrove, which was awarded the Small Rodeo of the Year for 2024 by The Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association (PRCA). Watch as the pros compete in bull riding, steer wrestling, bareback riding, tie-down roping, saddle bronc riding, barrel racing and team roping before rodeo season draws to a close.

Easy Ravioli Bake

If cheese ravioli is one of your go-to meals at your favorite Italian eatery, this Easy Ravioli Bake is sure to compete. Only ten minutes to prep, this baked ravioli is as easy as it gets for a quick, yet impressive, family dinner.

Ingredients

- 1 jar (25.5 oz.) Muir Glen™ organic pasta sauce (any variety)
- 1 package (25 to 27½ oz.) frozen cheese-filled ravioli
- 2 cups shredded mozzarella cheese (8 oz.)
- 2 tbsp grated Parmesan cheese

Directions

- ◆ Heat oven to 350°F. Spray bottom and sides of rectangular baking dish, 13x9x2-inches, with cooking spray.
- ◆ Spread ¾ cup of the pasta sauce in baking dish. Arrange half of the frozen ravioli in single layer over sauce; top with half of the remaining pasta sauce and 1 cup of the mozzarella cheese. Repeat layers once, starting with ravioli. Sprinkle with Parmesan cheese.
- ◆ Cover with foil; bake 40 minutes. Remove foil; bake 15 to 20 minutes or until bubbly and hot in center. Let stand 10 minutes before serving.

Van Service - *Camp Salute Residents Only*

Residents in need of transportation may contact the **People for People** office to make an appointment for ride service. However, residents **MUST** abide by the following guidelines:

- ◆ Van service is for **LOCAL** designations **ONLY**
- ◆ Shopping requests **MUST** be made at least 24 hours in advance
- ◆ Van service to local doctor appointments are for **VETERANS ONLY** - **MUST** provide at least **3 days notice**
- ◆ Doctor appointments are for **MORNING ONLY** (Van service is not available for afternoon appointments)
- ◆ Passengers **MUST BE AMBULATORY** (able to walk from one place to another) as van **is not** a medical vehicle (i.e., not equipped for wheel-chair bound passengers)
- ◆ Seating is limited to **5** adult passengers (No children)
- ◆ **Van service is not available on Fridays**
 - People for People use **ONLY (NO EXCEPTIONS)**

Riverstone Commons—Swedesboro

Located in Swedesboro, NJ. This is a new community that will feature 80 affordable apartments with 5 units set aside for homeless veteran families & individuals. Supportive services will be provided by **People for People Foundation**. Lease-up began June 10, 2026. Completion scheduled for 2026.

Apartments at Three Bridges —Hunterdon County

Located in Readington, Hunterdon County, NJ. This new community has 80 high-quality apartment homes with 5 units set aside for veterans at risk of being homeless. Lease-up began June 2, 2026. Completion scheduled for 2026.
