### HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES FOR VETERANS ONLY

**TAKE NOTICE**, the public is hereby informed that effective February 28, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. The Housing Authority of Gloucester County (HAGC) will be opening its Section 8 Project-Based Voucher Waiting list for eligible veterans seeking residence at Camp Salute in Clayton, New Jersey.

**Eligible applicants must be a United States Veterans with a DD214 and a discharge other than dishonorable. The DD214 must be provided at the time of application.**

Veterans currently on HAGC's Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher waiting list with a DD214 are also eligible to apply.

**FURTHER TAKE NOTICE**, the public is hereby informed that effective February 28, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. The Housing Authority of Gloucester County (HAGC) will be opening its Veterans Housing Choice Voucher Waiting list for eligible veterans with a DD214. The DD214 must be provided at the time of application.

Applying for the Camp Salute Project Based Voucher waiting list does not ensure your eligibility to receive Project Based assistance nor does it ensure that the owner and manager of Camp Salute will deem you a suitable candidate for occupancy.

Veterans who wish to apply for the Section 8 Project-Based Voucher and the Veterans Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Waiting list may **ONLY** do so by attending **Application Day on February 28, 2018** at Clayton Senior Citizen Center - One Garwood Boulevard, Clayton, NJ, 08312 from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. OR at [www.hagc.org](http://www.hagc.org) under the "Apply for Housing" tab OR by mailing a paper application to:
